Evaluation of Instructional Staff

POLICY # 0350

The Board of Cooperative Educational Services recognizes that education is a continuous process that cannot be satisfactorily achieved without the coordination and cooperation of all components of the entire system. To achieve the highest quality of education on all levels, a critical appraisal of all programs at each level is essential.

The purposes of evaluation of instruction are to:

1. indicate instructional strengths and weaknesses;
2. provide information needed for advance planning;
3. provide data for public information;
4. show the relationship between achievement and the stated goals of BOCES programs;
and
5. check on the suitability of instructional programs in terms of county requirements.

The District Superintendent will put in place a system which will provide for a continuing evaluation of instructional programs.
