**Advisory Council**

**POLICY # 1210**

The Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES) shall appoint an advisory council for occupational education consisting of at least ten members. The membership shall include, but not be limited to persons:

1. familiar with the vocational needs and problems of management and labor in the region;
2. familiar with programs of occupational education at the post-secondary and adult levels;
3. familiar with the manpower needs and requirements of the region to be served;
4. familiar with the special education needs of the physically and mentally handicapped; and
5. representative of community interests, including persons familiar with the special needs of the population to be served.

Advisory councils may appoint consultant committees representative of specific occupational fields to assist in the work of the council and the BOCES with respect to the planning, development and requirements for establishment of new programs or evaluation and revision of existing programs.

The BOCES may employ such professional, technical and clerical personnel as may be necessary to enable the advisory council to carry out its functions specified in this section.
