Drivers Education

POLICY # 4318

In accordance with state law, the Board of Cooperative Educational Services may offer instruction in the safe and lawful operation of a motor vehicle. The classroom instruction will emphasize the effects of drug and alcohol use, including the hazards of driving while impaired or intoxicated; the penalties for alcohol-related motor vehicle violations; and the medical, biological and physiological effects of the consumption of alcohol and their impact on the operation of a motor vehicle.

Classroom training will be provided by a person approved by the State Education Department and the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles. The law authorizes driver education classes to be conducted on a Saturday if necessary.
