Instructional Services

POLICY # 4520

Requests for services are made by component school districts with the Board of Cooperative Educational Services not later than February 1 of each year. The BOCES then submits its program to the State Department for approval not later than February 15 of each year, and notifies each component school district on or before March 10 concerning services which have been approved by the Commissioner. Each component school district notifies BOCES of its intentions to participate in shared services and the specific services which such district elects to utilize on or before May 1st.

At the request of the component school districts, and with the approval of the Commissioner of Education, BOCES may offer on a cooperative basis: school nurse teacher, attendance supervisor, supervisor of teachers; psychologist, dental hygienist, teachers of art, music, physical education, vocational subjects, guidance counselors, maintenance and operation of cafeteria or restaurant service for the use of pupils while at school, and such other services as the Commissioner of Education may approve.

Other services not specifically mentioned in the law, which have been approved by the Commissioner in specific situations, include:

- ✍✍ School Health Coordinator
